**SUMMARY MONITORING REPORT OF IMPLEMENTATION OF THREE  
DISBURSEMENTS OF WORLD BANK SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT GRANTS TO SBMCs OF  
HONG, MICHIKA AND MADAGALI LGEA IN ADAMAWA STATE 11<sup>th</sup> -15<sup>th</sup> MAY 2020.**

**INTRODUCTION:**

The World Bank is assisting in providing access to quality Basic Education in the insurgency affected States of Borno, Yobe , Adamawa, Bauchi, Gombe and Taraba of the North East Region of Nigeria.

**OBJECTIVES:**

- 1) To verify if whether or not the two million, five hundred thousand naira third school grant has hit the SBMC account in the seven LGEAs of Adamawa State under the SEPIP-AF World Bank Assisted Project.
- 2) To access the implementation status of the supported schools improvement plan by SBMC members as per approved action plan.
- 3) To view the quality of work and advise for effective implementation of the project at the school level
- 4) To ensure that the project has impact on the teaching and learning in the school.
- 5) To advise the SBMC members on the need to establish records on the project- cash book, SBMC Minutes book and other school data
- 6) To advise the SBMC members on any lingering problem associated with the project implementation of SEPIP AF at the School level
- 7) To produce 1 quarter 2020 report on the SEPIP-AF project implementation in the State for the World Bank consideration as the project round up 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020

A total of 57 Sample Schools both Primary and Junior Secondary Schools in 3 out of 7 Local Government Areas of Adamawa State were monitored by the

Consultant. The quality of the projects based on the approved school improvement plan were assessed. While effort is put for the other 4 LGEAs Monitoring

**IMPACT:**

All the SIP that deals with renovations, provision of seats and VIP toilets has significant impact on the learning process in the intervention schools as it has:-

- i. Increased Enrollment of pupils in the schools- more shelter and seat created.
- ii. Increased the attendance now that classrooms and seats are available over 95% attendance are recorded in the 77 schools of the 3 LGEAs Monitored.
- iii. SBMCs mobilization on project planning and execution is now high hence ownership of such SIP became paramount, as the quality of the work generally are good and standard, except very few cases.

IV. To evaluate the three grants utilization in the schools and give advise bearing in mind the Project round up on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020

## **OBSERVATIONS: ADAMAWA STATE**

Based on monitoring the three projects implemented at the school levels by the Consultant, the following are observed from Madagali, Michika and part of Hong LGEAs

- In the three LGEAs monitored Madagali, Michika and Hong of the seven LGAs there has been considerable progress in the improvement of schools infrastructure making them more child-friendly with more good classes, seats good drinking water ( Boreholes), VIP toilet etc.
- The commitment of the SBMC members, the prudent and accountability being exhibited on the management of funds is highly noted, and need to be appreciated.
- Need for award for best performed, SBMCs is required by ADSEPIP-AF at both State and National level, to encourage others
- That some schools are yet to get their grants, of 500,00,00, 1,000,000 naira and while others 2,5000,000,00, naira Such schools were advised by the Consultant to report to the ADSEPIP Yola with their print out Bank statement immediately as the project will terminate by 30 of June 2020.

## **WAYFORWARD:**

1. Monitoring was not carried out regularly by all levels of the ADSEPIP-AF, M & E unit, state office (M & E) and LGEA (ES, sectional Heads Supervisors) and Divisional Inspectors of Education (DIE) for JSS. In future projects monitoring and evaluation need to be intensified.
2. Screening of SIP be carried out by both M&E and the Consultant to avoid embarking on elephant projects that the grant cannot complete.
3. Transferred head teachers (Principals and Head Masters) should not handle the account when retired but the next appointed heads to take charge.
4. Awareness creation of the good projects carried out at low cost need to be made so that the general public can see and value the intervention of SEPIP-AF World Bank Project in Basic Education in Adamawa State as it complement Government efforts.
5. Special awards to the best performing SBMCs be made by the Ministry of Education, SUBEB and Post Primary School Management Boards in form of AWARD FOR THE BEST PERFORMING SCHOOL in implementing SEPIP-AF Projects.

**CONCLUSION:**

The school improvement project (SIP) is actually creating the desired objectives of increase in enrolment and attendance as the schools are now child- friendly. The case of Sabon layi primary school Madagali, Tsukumu primary school Bazza, Hausari, primary school Michika, Kabang Primary in Michika and Mubi-South respectively were renovations and provision of seats made attendance very high is a good innovation and welcome development in Basic Education.

Above all the involvement of the SBMC members has brought back ownership of improving access to quality Education. SBMC's are now looking in word for improving their schools through Resource Mobilization.


